RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, Blount County has proposed to the Department of Environment and Conservation that the county operate its own subsurface sewage disposal systems program; and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements is that the county program standards must be at least as stringent as those of the state law and regulations; and

WHEREAS, Blount County, in order to satisfy such requirement, wishes to adopt the minimum state regulations and other applicable laws; and


